Details:	<p>The Australian Government is inviting applications via an open process to apply for funding under the \$6 million National Agriculture Traceability Regulatory Technology Research and Insights Grant round.</p> <p>A national approach to traceability reform, with government and industry co-designing an efficient, streamlined, and internationally recognised traceability system, is central to the growth of Australia's agricultural sector. In support of this approach, this program is designed to align with the objectives under the draft National Agricultural Traceability Strategy 2023 to 2033 that was co-designed by industry and the department and was opened for consultation on 19 October 2022.</p> <p>Regulatory Technology (RegTech) is the use of technology to better achieve regulatory objectives and has the potential to support growth of the agricultural sector: leading the way for increased digitisation, streamlining compliance requirements, and creating opportunities to realise greater value.</p> <p>This grant program will provide opportunities for successful applicants to strengthen partnerships across industry sectors and government and contribute to the development of innovative and practicable proposals to increase the use of RegTech along agricultural supply chains. Research and insights will demonstrate how to leverage RegTech to enhance agricultural traceability reforms, and support growth of the agricultural sector.</p>

The grants are available to Australian organisations to undertake activities during the 2023 calendar year, aimed at raising awareness about organ and tissue donation among young people aged 16 to 25 and encouraging them to register as a donor. Funding for the grants has been separated into two categories – national events and innovative digital projects.</p>

Details:	<p>The Australian Government is inviting organisations, in an open competitive process, to apply to receive support under the Extension and Adoption of Drought Resilience Farming Practices Grants Program (the program) from 11 November 2022 to 9 January 2023.</p> <p>The objective of the program is to fund activities that support adoption of proven and existing Australian and/or internationally generated research and development (R&D) practices and technology that: reduce the impacts of drought on agricultural productivity and/or enable a quicker recovery of farmers and their lands from drought; have potential to be adopted at a large scale (either across multiple farms, a farming system, landscapes, regions or industries); Can demonstrate public benefits.</p> <p>Under the program, eligible applicants can apply for grants of between \$100,000 and \$3 million (GST exclusive) per application for projects up to 24 months. Successful projects must be carried out between June 2023 and June 2025. Applicants will be required to contribute funding (co-contribution/s) to the delivery of the project.</p>
