Details:	<p>The objective of the Program is to provide grants up to \$100,000 to assist caravan parks to swiftly upgrade or create new infrastructure and visitor facilities to enhance visitor experience, including improvements to accessibility and environmental sustainability practices.</p> <p>The intended outcomes of the Program are to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Increase the number of visitors seeking caravan park accommodation at a destination. • Increase a destination's attractiveness or capacity to meet visitor needs through new and improved infrastructure and facilities at local caravan parks. • Increase the capacity and improve the quality of caravan park infrastructure and facilities for visitors at a destination.

Details:	<p>The Australian Government is inviting community organisations to apply for a grant under the Safe and Together Community Grants Program (the program).</p> <p>The program will enable communities and organisations to deliver activities and programs to support, at the earliest possible stage, individuals who may be vulnerable to developing extremist views and behaviours.</p> <p>Three categories of activities will be considered for funding:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. activities that strengthen the Australian community's broader awareness of and resistance to extremism;

	<p>2. activities that empower communities and families to engage with vulnerable young people;</p> <p>3. activities that support individuals and their families who are successfully disengaging from extremist views.</p> <p>The outcomes that the program will aim to achieve are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • across Australia, communities will gain a general understanding of the nature of extremism and how to improve individual and community resilience to it; • at all levels, people will work together to identify risks and triggers that may lead vulnerable young people to extremist views and behaviours, and learn how to foster protective factors against those risks; • communities and organisations will be skilled in engaging and facilitating discussion with young people about violent extremist issues; <p>vulnerable young people are referred to appropriate support programs at an early stage, to reduce the risk of them becoming violent.</p>

Details:	<p>The Stillbirth and Miscarriage Support grant opportunity will contribute to actions under the National Stillbirth Action and Implementation Plan which calls for implementing best practice care for parents and families who experience stillbirth and perinatal loss.</p> <p>The purpose of the Stillbirth and Miscarriage Support grant opportunity is to provide high quality, evidence-based bereavement care to women and families in higher risk groups impacted by stillbirth and miscarriage.</p> <p>The grant opportunity will fund organisations with expertise in providing bereavement care for women and families at increased risk of stillbirth and poorer pregnancy outcomes including, but not limited to: Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples; culturally and linguistically diverse (CALD) families; refugee and migrant communities; women and families living in rural and remote Australia; and women younger than 20 years.</p> <p>The objectives of the grant opportunity are to develop and implement holistic and individualised bereavement care for women and families in target population groups that have experienced stillbirth or miscarriage.</p> <p>The bereavement care developed under this activity must align with the framework for respectful and supportive care as outlined in the Clinical Practice Guideline for Care Around Stillbirth and Neonatal Death and the quality statements for bereavement care and support after perinatal loss in the Stillbirth Clinical Care Standard.</p> <p>Successful applicant/s will need to work closely and consult with organisations undertaking existing national stillbirth and miscarriage activities, as well as with the relevant community organisations and target population groups.</p>
